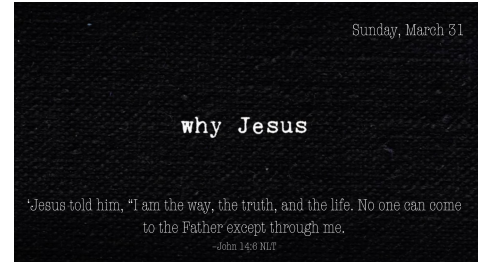


Why Jesus?
